- 45. To enter into partnership or into any arrangement for sharing profits, amalgamation, union of interest, co-operation, joint venture, reciprocal concession or otherwise or amalgamate with any person or Company carrying on or engaged in, or about to carry on or engage in business or transaction which the Company is authorised to carry on or act on and to take or otherwise acquire share and securities of any such company and to sell, hold, reissue with or without guarantee or otherwise deal with the same.
- 46. To enter into foreign or Indian technical and/or financial collaboration, partnership or into any arrangement for sharing of profits, union of interest, co-operation, joint venture, reciprocal concession or otherwise with any person, firm, corporation or government or company carrying on, engaged in or about to carry on or engage in business, undertaking or transaction which the Company is authorised to carry on or engage in or business undertaking or transaction which may seem capable of being carried on or conducted so as to directly or indirectly benefit the Company, to guarantee contracts or otherwise assign any such person, firm or company and to take

or otherwise acquire and hold shares or securities of any such persons firms or companies, to sell, hold, re-issue with or without guarantee or otherwise deal with the same.

- 47. To acquire and undertake the whole or any part of the business, property and liabilities of any person, firm or any Company carrying on business which the Company is authorized to carry on or possessed of property suitable for the business of the Company.
- 48. To purchase, take on lease or otherwise acquire any land, grants, concessions and easement and hereditaments or other properties required for the attainment of the main objects of the Company.
- 49. To adopt such means of making known the business of the Company as may seem expedient and in particular by advertising in the press, by circulars, by purchase and exhibition of works of art or interests, by publication of books and periodicals and by granting prizes and rewards.
- 50.  - Franchise
- IV. The objects of the Company extend to the territories comprised in the Union of India.
 - The profits, if any, or other Income and properties of the Company, whensoever derived, shall be applied, solely for the promotion of its objects as set forth in this memorandum.
 - No portion of the profits, other Income or Property aforesaid shall be paid or transferred, directly or indirectly by ways of dividend, bonus or otherwise by way

of profit, to persons, who at any time are, or have been members of the Company, or to any one or more of them or to any persons claiming through any one or more of them.

- No remuneration or other benefit in money or monies worth shall be given by the Company to any of its members, whether officers or servants of the Company or not except payment of out of pocket expenses, reasonable and proper interest on money lent, or reasonable and proper rent on premises let to the Company.
- 4. Nothing in this clause shall prevent the payment by the company in good faith of prudent remuneration to any of its officers or servants (not being members) or to any other person (not being member), in return for any services actually rendered to the company.
- Nothing in clauses 3 & 4 shall prevent the payment by the company in good faith
 of prudent remuneration to any of its members in return for any services (not
 being services of a kind which are required to be rendered by a member), actually
 rendered to the company.
- V. No alteration shall be made to this Memorandum of Association or to the Articles of Association of the Company, which are for the time being in force, unless the alteration has been previously submitted to and approved by the Registrar of Companies.
- VI. The liability of the members is limited.
- VII. The authorized share capital of the company will be Rs. 15,00,000 (Fifteen Lakhs Only) divided into 1,50,000 (One Lakhs Fifty Thousand Only) shares of Rs. 10 (Rupees Ten) each.
- VIII. (1) True accounts shall be kept of all sums of money received and expended by the Company and the matters in respect of which such receipts and expenditure take place, and of the properties, credits and liabilities of the Company and subject to any reasonable restrictions as to the time and manner of inspecting the same, that may be imposed in accordance with the regulations of the Company for the time being in force.
